Projects must have been completed within the geographical boundaries of Lombard within the last five years. Projects will be judged according to their impact on the community, quality and degree of difficulty, and the degree to which they serve as an example of excellence in historic preservation and influence others.

Please select a category for your nomination from the following:

Adaptive Use/Rehabilitation – Conversion of a historic structure for a new or compatible use while retaining its architectural integrity

Lifetime Achievement – professional or volunteer individual who has contributed to the preservation movement over the length of their career.

Advocacy/Education – An effective campaign to save a historic resource or an innovative program, publication or media initiative that communicates the value of historic preservation to the general public.

New Construction – Sensitive new design project built within the existing scale of a historic area. Contemporary designs accepted and encouraged.

Leadership/Stewardship – Individual, private organization or joint partnership that has championed historic preservation, planning or public policy. This category also includes thoughtful maintenance and/or continued use of a historic resource by its owner(s).

Restoration – Removing incompatible alterations and reconstructing missing elements to reflect a building's historic appearance in a given era.

Application Checklist: Use the following checklist to insure that your nomination is complete. Each nomination should include:

- ✓ This completed application form
- ✓ A typed statement (500 word max) signed by the nominator describing the project being nominated
- ✓ At least 2 additional letters of recommendation
- ✓ For building projects: include "before" and "after" floor plans if possible
- ✓ "Before" and "After" photographs documenting the project. Photos should clearly relate to the narrative and demonstrate positive results. Include a descriptive label, caption and credit line for publication with all photos.
- ✓ Nominations for group or organizational efforts should include a photo of the nominees and photos of the specific project(s) for which the group is being nominated.
- ✓ A copy of any publications or newspaper clippings related to the nomination.
