Dear Resident,

The Public Works Department will host a public information meeting for the Highland Avenue Sewer Separation Project on Thursday, April 10, 2025, from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM. The meeting will be held in the Front Conference Room at the Public Works facility, located at 1051 South Hammerschmidt Avenue. Public Works is situated within the Village Complex, just south of Village Hall.

Staff from the Public Works Department, along with the Village's consultant from Thomas Engineering of Oak Brook, will be available to answer any questions.

Streets included in the project are:

- Chase Avenue (South Broadway to Division Street)
- Division Street (Chase Avenue to Highland Avenue)

The main purpose of the project is to install large-diameter storm sewers on both Chase Avenue and Division Street. Some adjustments will be made to the existing water main to accommodate the new storm sewer installation. The project also includes drainage improvements at the Chase/Division intersection, ADA-compliant sidewalk replacements, pavement patching on Chase Avenue, and installing new curb, gutter, and asphalt pavement on Division Street.

Construction is expected to begin in late April/Early May and be completed by October 2025. To keep residents informed, newsletters and door hangers will be distributed periodically. Residents should sign up for the electronic notification system (Notify Me) to stay updated on contractor activities and the progress of construction. Please refer to the bottom of this letter for instructions.

## Access/Parking Permits



- Residents will have access during most construction
  - Village will issue parking permits
- Driveway access may be restricted when the contractor is working in the area
  - Typical workday (7 AM – 4 PM)
- During the installation of Curb & Gutter, Base Course and Paving residents will need to park on nearby streets - 3 to 4 week duration
