Construction and Impact on Driveway Access

Dear Resident,

Enclosed are two permits that allow overnight street parking in areas where it is normally prohibited. If your household has more than two vehicles, you may request additional permits by contacting Public Works at (630) 620-5740 or publicworks@villageoflombard.org.

During construction, overnight street parking will be permitted on nearby streets adjacent to the work zone. Do not park in permit spots along South Broadway.

Parking Guidelines

- Parking permits are only required for overnight street parking. Other regular parking restrictions remain in effect.
- Vehicles parked on the street overnight must display a valid Village-issued parking permit. Vehicles without a permit may be ticketed.
- **Do not park in or near construction zone entrances.** Do not park in front of fire hydrants, driveways, or in areas where parking is prohibited.
- If you need overnight parking for guests or visitors, please visit <https://www.villageoflombard.org/318/Overnight-Parking> or contact the Police Department at (630) 873-4400. Provide the vehicle details and the planned parking location.

Please plan for the following access restrictions:

- **Underground utility construction:** Daytime access will periodically be limited in the area where the contractor is working. Be aware of the contractor's progress.
- **Sidewalk replacement:** Driveway access may be restricted for approximately three days to seven days.
- **Roadway reconstruction (Division Street):** Expect to be without driveway access for up to three weeks.

Storm sewer and water main construction will commence first. Followed by sidewalk, curb, and gutter construction in early to mid-August. Paving of the roadway is currently scheduled for early to mid-September. The final surface of asphalt will be placed in late September. Separate notices regarding access will be distributed in advance of each construction phase. These notices will include information about the work and information about access to your driveway.
