The Lombard Police Department now offers a Blue Envelope Program to help improve communication between police officers and individuals on the autism spectrum during traffic stops or other encounters. This program is designed to reduce stress and support safer, more positive interactions for everyone involved.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Blue Envelope is a bright, easy-to-recognize tool that can be handed to an officer during a traffic stop or other encounter. It signals that the individual may have communication differences or specific support needs.

The envelope can include:

- ✓ Driver's license or state ID
- ✓ Vehicle registration and insurance
- ✓ Emergency contact information
- ✓ Notes about communication preferences or support needs

HOW IT WORKS

Participation is free and voluntary. No registration or proof of diagnosis is required.

To get started:

- ✓ Pick up an envelope at the Police Station or Village Hall
- ✓ Fill in any relevant information
- ✓ Add copies of important documents
- ✓ Keep it with you or in your vehicle
