July 26, 2019

The new building (*Pressure Adjusting Station/Storage Garage*) and the Commuter/Shopper parking lots are all nearing completion.

Weather permitting, the patches in the south bound lane of North Main Street and west bound lane of East St. Charles Road are scheduled to be completed on Wednesday, July 31st. Be sure to allow some extra time to travel in those respective lanes on the 31st.

Site work is complete except for the surface layer of asphalt and striping. Various trades are working to complete the new building.

The “shopper lot” (2 hour or less parking) portion (southwest section) of the site is still open for use until both parking lots have the surface layer paved and the parking spots striped and signed. The lot will be closed during those operations.

Another notice will be posted prior to the commuter lot re-opening in mid-August.

For those who are interested in the re-opening of the commuter lot and progress of the project, refer to the back of this notice to sign-up for “Notify Me”. This is an electronic service through which the Village will give brief updates concerning the progress of project and reopening of the parking lot.

E-mail is one of the quickest and most efficient means to distribute information to many individuals. The Village of Lombard Public Works Department highly encourages the use of “Notify Me”. This system allows residents and other interested parties to receive information about the project electronically instead of relying on mailed or hand delivered newsletters. “Notify Me” allows for residents to receive information as soon as possible, without the inconvenience of having letters tucked in doorways where the paper is exposed to weather conditions. For example, once driveway access is restricted or altered during the construction of the curb and pavement, residents will need to receive updates as quickly as possible.

“Notify Me” is a function of the Village website through which the Village can e-mail and text updates along with any urgent information. When your account is established, an e-mail will be sent you. The e-mail will come from Public Works Department (listserv@civicplus.com). Click on the link within the e-mail to activate your subscription.

Step 1: Sign up for “Notify Me” at www.villageoflombard.org/notifyme

Step 2: Open the email you receive back from Public Works. listserv@civicplus.com. **BE SURE TO CHECK JUNK MAIL OR SPAM FOLDER(S).**

Step 3: Click the link provided and “Notify Me” will be activated.
