

FAQs: Restaurant Closures

What is Executive Order 2020-07?

Illinois Governor Pritzker issued Executive Order 2020-07 on March 16, 2020 in response to Covid-19. This mandates the closure of all businesses in the State of Illinois that offer food or beverages for on-premises consumption. However, certain provisions apply.

Can I still eat at my favorite restaurants?

You cannot dine-in at any restaurant. Food and beverages must be consumed off-premises.

What can I do?

You can order food from your favorite restaurants! You can pick-up the food yourself or via curbside. The restaurant or a third-party can deliver the food to you. Drive-throughs are also allowed. Additionally, you can purchase gift cards to use later.

If you pick-up food please remember the CDC recommends social distancing of at least six feet (6'). If you are a restaurant owner/manager please ensure your customers and staff are practicing social distancing.

What restaurants are open for carry out or delivery?

Many local establishments are posting how they will continue to operate drive-up or drive-thru service in compliance with this directive. Residents are encouraged to connect with individual locations and support local Lombard businesses where practicable. When I pick-up my food can I have a beer or other beverage while I wait?

Sorry, but you can't. The Executive Order mandates no on-site food or beverage consumption.

What about hotels?

Hotels can sell food and beverage via room service, mini-bar, or carry-out.
