



## 5.1.20 Village of Lombard COVID-19 Update

On Friday, April 23, 2020, Illinois Governor JB Pritzker announced his intention to issue a modified version of the current Stay-At-Home Mandate. The order extends the current State Stay-At-Home order through May 30th (previously set to expire April 30th), with [certain modifications](#). Below is information regarding changes to the original order that will be implemented May 1, 2020.

### FACE COVERINGS

Any individual over age 2 and able to medical tolerate a face-covering shall cover their nose and mouth “when in in a public place and unable to maintain a six-foot social distance.” Face coverings are required in public indoor spaces such as stores.

### SPECIAL RETAIL STORE REQUIREMENTS

- Retail stores that are essential businesses shall:
- Cap occupancy at 50% of store capacity
- Set up store aisles to be one-way and conspicuously identify them as such with signage or floor markings
- Communicate social distancing to customers through signage, PSAs and advertisements
- Discontinue use of reusable bags Households should limit the number of members entering store to minimum necessary

### NON-ESSENTIAL STORES

Non-essential stores that were previously prohibited from opening may re-open to fulfill phone and online orders through pick-up outside of the store and delivery. Employees must follow social distancing and wear face coverings

### MANUFACTURERS

Must follow social distancing and take certain precautions, including providing face coverings, staggering shifts, operating only essential lines, downsize operations to the extent necessary to allow social distancing and provide a safe workplace

### OUTDOOR ACTIVITY

Specific state parks will reopen. Fishing and boating of groups of no more than 2 people permitted. Golf permitted subject to limitations.

The Village of Lombard and the Lombard Park District have issued a joint statement, reminding residents that the Stay-At-Home Order will continue through May 31st and social distancing remains in place in public/outdoor spaces. We hope to continue providing safe opportunities for the community to get

**DO:**

- ✓ Make sure you can breathe through it
- ✓ Wear it whenever going out in public
- ✓ Make sure it covers your nose and mouth
- ✓ Wash after using

**DON'T:**

- ✗ Use on children under age 2
- ✗ Use surgical masks or other personal protective equipment (PPE) intended for health care workers

**How to Wear a Cloth Face Covering**  
Cloth face coverings should:

- fit snugly but comfortably against the side of the face
- be secured with ties or ear loops
- include multiple layers of fabric
- allow for breathing without restriction
- be able to be laundered and machine dried without damage or change to shape

### **ESSENTIAL BUSINESS REQUIREMENTS**

Must provide employees with appropriate face coverings and require that employees wear face coverings where maintaining 6' social distance is not possible at all times. Should also provide additional PPE when work circumstances require.
