The agenda for this meeting does include a resolution seeking consideration of a localized/county approach to re-open business and resume civic activity on behalf of the Village of Lombard. This resolution is consistent with the position of the Illinois Municipal League and other surrounding towns in that it asks for the Governor's Restore Illinois Plan to be modified to take into account the differences between DuPage County and other areas of the State. The resolution asks for this to be done consistent with sound public health practices and a phased in approach. However, it is intended to allow for a more efficient and timely movement through the phases of the Restore Illinois Plan.
