Phase 3 of Restore Illinois Plan Begins May 29

Lombard is on track to move from Phase 2 to Phase 3 of the State's 5 Phase Reopen Illinois Plan, along with certain modifications, beginning Friday, May 29. Village staff is working with local businesses to find creative solutions to support reopening, while adhering to the State's guidelines.

- Health & Fitness Businesses
- Manufacturing Businesses
- Offices
- Personal Care Services (Salons, barbershops, spas)
- Restaurants and Bars for outdoor service
- Retail businesses
- Service Counters
- Youth Sports

Park Avenue Patio

The Village has worked with local businesses to develop a shared outdoor eating space called Park Avenue Patio, that complies with regulations, in downtown Lombard. Park Avenue Patio is a space designed for consuming food and beverages purchased to-go from local restaurants and taverns, while remaining in compliance with the State's COVID-19 regulations.
