DuPage County will be offering community-based COVID-19 testing at the DuPage County Complex, beginning Tuesday, June 16. The entrance is located on County Farm Road a few

blocks North of Roosevelt Road at a stoplight. The testing site will be available 7 a.m. - 3 p.m., Tuesday - Saturday, pending daily test capacity.
