



COVID-19 Update: Monday, June 22, 2020

Phase 4 of Restore Illinois Plan Scheduled to Begin June 26

Lombard is on track to move from Phase 3 to Phase 4 of the State's 5 Phase Reopen Illinois Plan, along with certain modifications, beginning Friday, June 26. The transition to Phase 4 depends on continued decreases in COVID-19 cases.

The State has issued [specific Phase-4 guidelines](#) for different industries. Restrictions will still be in place, but will be relaxed for indoor dining at restaurants, health & fitness, movies & theaters, museums, attractions and more.

- Meetings & Events: Resume business with 50% or less of the overall room capacity.
- Indoor and Outdoor recreation: Indoor recreation (bowling alleys, skating rinks) can operate 50% or less capacity. No groups larger than 50.
- Indoor dining: Groups of 10 or less permitted, with tables spaced 6-feet apart in seated areas, and standing areas no more than 25% of capacity.
- Theaters: May reopen with 50% of capacity or less.
- Health & Fitness Centers: Gyms may reopen to 50% capacity or lower and allow group fitness classes of up to 50 people with guidelines.
