One-Way Traffic Southbound Only

The upcoming underground utility construction will require that traffic be temporarily restricted to southbound only. This is necessary since the contractor will be trenching across the roadway to install new water and sewer services between Prairie Avenue and Pleasant Lane. New fire hydrants, water main, and sanitary sewer will also be installed within that same area. North of Pleasant Avenue, the water and sewer work will be primarily trenchless. Some limited excavation will be needed to install new hydrants and trenching pits to line the existing water main. Message boards will be in place to relay the anticipated start date of the establishment of the one-way. For the limits of the one-way refer to the map on the reverse side of this letter.

Water Shutdowns

There will be several periods during which water service will be temporarily interrupted to install a new water main, line the existing water main, transfer water services, and install new fire hydrants. It is recommended to keep water on hand and be alert for door hanger notices regarding shutdowns.

Mail Service

As part of the one-way traffic, those properties that have curbside mail service will use temporary mailbox banks. A forthcoming newsletter outlining the process and the location of the boxes will be sent before mail service is transferred. This is being coordinated with the USPS. Curbside service will be reinstated as soon as the contractor no longer requires the one-way traffic restriction.

Waste Management Collections

As part of the change to the traffic pattern, refuse/recycling/yard waste collection will be collected between 6:00-7:00 AM. All containers should be curbside before 6:00 AM.

Parking Permits

Overnight parking permits will be mailed to those residents who will have their driveway apron and/or sidewalk disturbed. A separate notification with additional details will be mailed to those addresses.

Please remove any personal property from the Village right-of-way. The Village will not assume liability for private items left within the right of way. If you have an underground lawn sprinkler system, sump pump line, or electrical wiring located in the parkway, please contact Lombard Public Works as soon as possible.
