Sidewalk and Driveway Restoration



Sidewalk and apron concrete work is scheduled for Tuesday, July 25th, and Wednesday, July 26th. Vehicles must be out of the driveways by 6:30 AM on Tuesday 25th. A few squares of sidewalk will be left gapped for resident access. Please use the gaps to access your home and do not walk on the fresh concrete for the first 24 hours.

Barricades will be left on driveway aprons for approximately 3 to 5 days after the concrete has been placed. The barricades will be removed and access restored after test results indicate that the concrete has sufficiently cured to support the weight of motor vehicles. **This notice applies to those locations where a driveway apron or a portion of the sidewalk aside the apron has been removed.**



If your driveway and/or apron are not being replaced, please park offsite while the contractor is working. This is a safety measure as there will be multiple trucks and workers in the construction zone.

Use your parking passes to park on adjacent side streets and follow all posted parking restrictions. **Do not park by fire hydrants, mailboxes, or near any intersections.** Workers and delivery trucks require room to enter and leave the job site.
