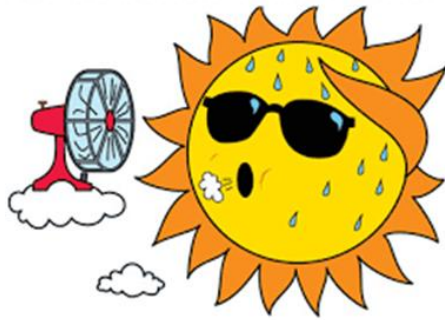


N. Grace Street Utility Improvements

Concrete Work and Driveway Access

Dear Resident:

July 25, 2023



Due to the hot weather, the contractor will be starting work at 6:00 AM on Wednesday, July 26th

Weather permitting, apron and curb work is scheduled for Wednesday, July 26th. Residents may use the sidewalk that was placed Tuesday. In the event of rain Wednesday morning, work will be postponed until Thursday.



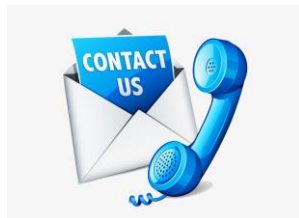
Reminder: Barricades will be left on driveway aprons for approximately 3 to 5 days after the concrete has been placed. The barricades will be removed and access restored after test results indicate that the concrete has sufficiently cured to support the weight of motor vehicles.



Even if your driveway and/or apron are not being replaced, please still park offsite while the contractor is working. This is a safety measure as there will be multiple trucks and workers in the construction zone.



Use your parking passes to park on adjacent side streets and follow all posted parking restrictions. **Do not park by fire hydrants, mailboxes, or near any intersections.** Workers and delivery trucks require room to enter and leave the job site.
