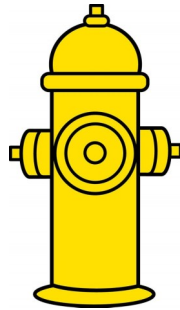

## Project Update

### Progress:

The contractor has completed the water main installation work from the mid-300 block to the Pleasant Lane intersection, and those water services will be connected as soon as the main is formally approved by the IEPA. Within that same area, the contractor will install a new sanitary sewer main and cleanouts, and replace a small section of each service connection. This work may effect your ingress and egress. Look for orange door hangers informing you about access limitations.

Multiple fire hydrants and water valve installations remain from Pleasant Lane to Goebel Drive. Concurrent with these activities, the contractor will be lining the remaining 6" diameter water main. A number of access pits will be dug and then covered with plates. Residents connected to that water main have received a letter from the Village outlining what to expect.

Residents between Pleasant Lane and Berkshire Avenue and also between

Marcus Drive and LeMoyne Avenue will soon have their sanitary sewer main lined. Those residents will receive a notice regarding the process and how it will temporarily affect their service.

Pavement and driveway restoration is underway south of View St.
