The Department of Public Works will hold a public information meeting on **June 13, 2024, at 5:30 PM in the Village Hall Board Room** related to the Large Diameter Combined Sewer Rehabilitation construction project. Public Works staff and the project design engineer, Christopher B. Burke Engineering LTD of Rosemont (CBBEL), will present the proposed improvements and the impacts/disruptions residents should expect during construction. Afterward, Village and CBBEL staff will be available to answer questions and review the project plans with residents.

The project primarily utilizes trenchless technology. A spray-on geopolymer shall be used on the large-diameter pipes (90", 96", and 108") and a Cured-In-Place Pipe (CIPP) will be used to rehabilitate a 30" diameter sewer that runs under Route 53 and I-355. Work will involve bypass pumping of the sewage, sewer cleaning and televising, manhole lining, lateral service connections, installation of sewer cleanouts, and traffic control. When the contractor is working near your home, expect temporary traffic rerouting. Village staff will work with USPS and Waste Management to ensure the mail service and refuse pickup during construction.

Affected streets include.

- ◆ Fairfield Avenue (Maple St. to Washington Blvd.)
- ◆ Washington Boulevard (Fairfield Ave. to Main St.)
- ◆ Green Valley Subdivision Rear Yards (between Park Rd. and Elizabeth St.)  
Elizabeth Ct., Park Ct., Lincoln Ct., Hickory Rd., & W. Washington Blvd.
- ◆ Hickory Street (Elizabeth St. to Vance St.)

Construction is anticipated to begin in late June or early July and conclude in November. The contractor is projected to remobilize in the following Spring and conclude work that Summer. The Village will periodically post newsletters and supplemental information on the Village website project page (<https://www.villageoflombard.org/544/FY2024-Large-Diameter-Combined-Sewer-Reh>). The construction schedule will be posted on the project page before the contractor mobilizes.

The primary construction communication tool will be Notify Me. Residents are encouraged to sign up for this electronic notification system (<https://www.villageoflombard.org/list.aspx?ListID=260>). If you cannot attend, the PowerPoint presentation will be posted on the project page on June 17th.
